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The Court, having considered the Motion of Thomas C. Hebrank ("Receiver"), Court-appointed permanent receiver for COPELAND WEALTH MANAGEMENT, A FINANCIAL ADVISORY CORPORATION. AND COPELAND WEALTH MANAGEMENT, A REAL ESTATE CORPORATION and their subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively, the "Receivership Entities"), for an Order: (1) Authorizing Appointment of a Liquidating Trustee and Approving Liquidating Trust Agreement; (2) Approving the Receiver's Final Report and Accounting; (3) Authorizing Destruction of Documents and Termination of Certain Receivership Entities; (4) Authorizing Payment of Final Fees; and (5) Discharging and Releasing Receiver, and all papers in support of the Motion, and good cause appearing therefor, hereby orders as follows:

- 1. The Motion is hereby granted;
- 2. The Court finds that the Receiver duly and fully complied with his duties and obligations as Receiver;
- 3. The Court hereby approves the form of the Liquidating Trust 17 Agreement attached as Exhibit "A" to the Declaration of Thomas C. Hebrank filed in support of the Motion ("Hebrank Declaration"), and directs the Receiver to file an application with the Court identifying his preferred Liquidation Trustee and containing the individual's qualifications and his proposed fee;
 - 4. The Court hereby approves the Receiver's Final Report and Accounting;
 - 5. The Court hereby authorizes termination of, and destruction of all documents relating to, the remaining Receivership Entities, except to the extent that the Receiver believes any Receivership Entities are required to operate, or documents are necessary. for future /////

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administration of post-Receivership affairs, to be handled by the liquidating trustee;

- Upon entry of this Order, the Receivership is terminated the 6. Receiver's Counsel is hereby discharged and released from all duties relating to the Receivership and shall have no further liabilities or responsibilities herein; and
- Upon completion of the "Final Closing Tasks" as defined in 7. section IV of the Memorandum of Points and Authorities filed in support of the Motion, the Receiver is discharged and released from all duties relating to the Receivership Estate and shall have no further liabilities or responsibilities as Receiver herein.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
