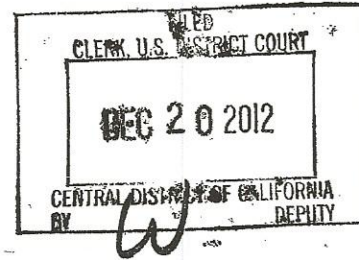

2 therefor,


3 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:
