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The Court having considered the motion of Krista L. Freitag ("Receiver"), receiver for American Home Servicing Center, LLC, Capital Home Advocacy Center, LLC, National Advocacy Center, LLC, and their subsidiaries and affiliates ("Receivership Entities") for an order, to Conclude Receivership and for Order: (1) approving final accounting and report; (2) approving disposition/transfer of books and records; and (3) discharging receiver (Motion, Doc. 131), and good cause appearing therefor: **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** as follows: The Motion is granted; 1. 2. The Receiver's final accounting and report is approved and accepted as the Receiver's final report and accounting to the Court; 3. The Receiver is authorized to reimburse herself for actual costs incurred up to \$1,603.61 from remaining cash in the receivership estate; The disposition and transfer of the Receivership Entities' books and 4. records described in the Motion is approved; 5. The Receiver is discharged of all duties under the Ex Parte Temporary Restraining Order with Asset Freeze, Appointment of Temporary Receiver, Limited Expedited Discovery, and Order to Show Cause Why Preliminary Injunction Should Not Issue ("TRO") entered by the Court on April 13, 2018 (Dkt. No. 13), the Preliminary Injunction with Asset Freeze, Appointment of Receiver, Limited Expedited Discovery, and Other Equitable Relief as to Defendants American Home Servicing Center, LLC, Capital Home Advocacy Center, LLC, National Advocacy Center, LLC, and Marcus Fierro ("Preliminary Injunction Order") entered by this Court on April 10, 2014 (Dkt. No. 43), and subsequent orders of the Court. Pursuant to the discharge, the Receiver is released from any and all claims and liabilities associated with the receivership, the receivership entities, and the individual defendants named in this action;

- 6. All actions taken by the Receiver and her professionals in preserving, management, administering the receivership estate were consistent with the powers and duties assigned to the Receiver the Court's Orders; accordingly, all actions taken by the Receiver and her professionals in performing the Receiver's Court-ordered duties under the TRO, Preliminary Injunction Order, and subsequent orders of the Court are approved and ratified;

 7. The Receiver is hereby discharged from all further duties and responsibilities relating to the receivership without any further liability or obligation or responsibility for payment of liabilities of the Receivership Entities, the Receiver being entitled to those immunities and liability protections traditionally accorded to
 - 8. The receivership is closed; and
- 9. Jurisdiction over all disputes, claims, and causes of action arising from or relating to this receivership case is reserved to this Court.
