I, Ted Fates, declare as follows:

- 1. I am an attorney at the law firm of Allen Matkins Leck Gamble Mallory & Natsis LLP, counsel of record for Plaintiff Thomas C. Hebrank ("Receiver"), the court-appointed receiver for First Financial Planning Corporation d/b/a Western Financial Planning Corporation ("Western"), in the above-captioned action. I make this declaration in support of the Receiver's Motion for Civil Contempt and Sanctions for Violation of Preliminary Injunction Order ("Motion"). I am a member in good standing of the State Bar of California and have been admitted to practice before this Court. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this Declaration and, if called as a witness, could and would testify competently to such facts under oath.
- 2. On September 3, 2014, the Receiver contacted the Partnership Administrators and advised that the Receiver would need full access to the servers. The Partnership Administrators responded that Schooler would not grant such access and the Receiver would have to address the issue with Schooler's counsel.
- 3. On September 4, 2014, I sent a letter to Schooler's counsel demanding immediate access to the Western server. I noted in my correspondence that the PI Order requires Schooler to provide access and that failure to do so would violate the PI Order. I also gave notice that the Receiver would seek sanctions if Schooler violated the PI Order. Attached as **Exhibit A** is a true and correct copy of my letter sent on September 4, 2014.
- 4. Schooler's counsel, Eric Hougen, responded to my letter by calling me and demanding a full retraction of my letter, stating there was no basis to allege Schooler had violated the PI Order and that Schooler was not denying the Receiver access to the server. I told Mr. Hougen the Receiver would provide a date and time for Geno Rodriguez from the Receiver's office and the Receiver's IT specialist to visit the Vista office to access the server.

- 5. On September 8, 2014, I sent an e-mail to Schooler's counsel requesting Mr. Rodriguez and the IT specialist have access to the server on September 11, 2014. Attached as **Exhibit B** is a true and correct copy of my September 8, 2014 e-mail.
- 6. On September 10, 2014, Schooler's counsel, David Herman, responded that "[b]ecause it is unclear what exactly will be performed by Mr. Hebrank and/or Mr. Rodriguez and the IT technician, Messrs. Dyson and Hougen will need to be present to oversee the process and ensure that only non-confidential electronically-stored information belonging to Western (and not to Mr. Schooler, the LinMar entities, or other entities not within the scope of the receivership) is accessed." Mr. Herman also stated that the server access would need to be conducted on September 15, 2014, due to Mr. Hougen and Mr. Dyson's schedules. Attached as **Exhibit C** is a true and correct copy of Mr. Herman's September 10, 2014 e-mail.
- 7. I responded the same day, stating that September 15, 2014, would not work because the Receiver's IT specialist was leaving for vacation that day. Instead, the Receiver proposed that the server be picked up on Friday, September 12, 2014, and returned on Monday, September 15, 2014. *See* Exhibit C.
- 8. On September 11, 2014, Schooler's counsel called me and stated that there are files unrelated to Western on the server that need to be removed before the server could be turned over. Schooler's counsel stated they would promptly review the files on the server with the aid of an IT technician and remove the non-Western files. On behalf of the Receiver, I agreed on the condition that a log of the files removed be provided, to which Schooler's counsel agreed. It was agreed that the file review and removal would be completed promptly and certainly before the Receiver's IT specialist returned from vacation on September 29, 2014.
- 9. On September 17, 2014, Mr. Herman e-mailed me and advised that Mr. Dyson had been inspecting the "computers and servers at Western Financial's offices and will continue his inspection tomorrow with the aid of an IT technician." Mr. Herman stated that Mr. Dyson would contact me the next day with a status

update. Attached as **Exhibit D** is a true and correct copy of Mr. Herman and my email communication from September 17 to September 29, 2014.

- 10. On September 22, 2014, I followed up, requesting an update on the status of the file review and removal. *See* **Exhibit D**. Schooler's counsel did not respond.
- 11. On September 29, 2014, I followed up again, stating the Receiver's IT specialist was back from vacation and ready to pick up the server, that Schooler had had ample time since September 4, 2014, to remove the non-Western files, and therefore the Receiver's IT person would pick up the server at the Vista office the following day. *See* **Exhibit D**.
- 12. That same day, Mr. Dyson responded, stating the server would not be available for pick up, that he was not feeling well, and that he would get back to me tomorrow if he was in. *See* **Exhibit D**.
- 13. On September 30, 2014, I had two telephone calls with Schooler's counsel. During those calls, Schooler's counsel stated they had made a copy of Western's server, were reviewing the copy, and would then have the non-Western files removed. Schooler's counsel acknowledged the file review and removal had taken far too long and agreed the server would be provided on October 8, 2014, regardless of whether the non-Western files had been removed by that time. Schooler's counsel stated that a copy of the Western server had been made and would be reviewed in order to identify non-Western files. In order to avoid seeking Court intervention and incurring costs associated with a contempt motion, the Receiver agreed to October 8, 2014, as the absolute deadline to produce the server.
- 14. On October 7, 2014, I sent an e-mail to Mr. Dyson to confirm the server would be made fully available to the Receiver the following morning. Mr. Dyson responded saying only he would "not be able to make that time" and would address it

Schooler never requested permission to make a copy of the Western server and such permission was never granted.

- further with me the next day. I responded that the Receiver had been waiting more than a month and if Schooler could not provide a set time on October 8 or October 9, the Receiver would be forced to seek relief from the Court. Attached as **Exhibit E** is a true and correct copy of Mr. Dyson and my October 7, 2014 correspondence.
- 15. On October 8, 2014, Mr. Dyson responded, stating that a copy of the server had been made, but the non-Western files had not been removed. I responded the same day, again advising that if full access to the server was not provided on October 9, 2014 the Receiver would seek an order compelling Schooler to comply with the PI Order. I noted that their promise to provide the Western server no later than October 8, 2014 had been broken, which Mr. Dyson did not deny. Attached as **Exhibit F** is a true and correct copy of Mr. Dyson and my October 8, 2014 e-mails.
- 16. Before the hearing held on October 10, 2014, Mr. Dyson told me a copy of the Western server would probably be ready by October 15, 2014. At the conclusion of the hearing, I attempted to raise this issue with the Court, but Schooler's counsel objected and the Court declined to take up the matter. I explained the Receiver was hoping to avoid incurring the expense of a motion.
- 17. As of the date of this motion, almost two months from when access to the Western server was requested, Schooler has not granted such access.
- 18. Along with attorney Josi Swonetz, I prepared the Motion in support of which this declaration is submitted. My discounted hourly rate is \$463.50/hr. and Ms. Swonetz's is \$387/hr. The Receiver respectfully requests the Court issue an order for sanctions against Schooler in the amount of \$11,294.55, for the attorney fees incurred as a result of Schooler's failure to comply with the PI Order, including, but not limited to, the fees incurred in bringing this Motion. Attached as **Exhibit G** is a summary of the time billed related to the recovery of the Western server. *Intel Corp. v. Terabyte Intl'l*, 6 F3d 614, 623 (9th Cir. 1993) (summaries of billing records are sufficient to establish fees incurred so long as underlying records are made

available pursuant to Federal Rule of Evidence 1006). A breakdown of the attorney fees incurred is provided below.²

Ted,

I understood from our telephone conversation yesterday that you were going to issue a full retraction of your letter dated September 3, 2014 and transmitted by email to Phil and me yesterday, September 4, 2014. Instead, your email below does not retract your letter, and the very serious accusations you made in your letter against Mr. Schooler remain. Your letter unequivocally states that "By refusing to grant the Receiver access to the servers, Mr. Schooler has violated the Preliminary Injunction Order." You had sufficient information prior to writing your letter to know that this statement is and was inaccurate and false.

You wrote this letter despite the fact that neither yourself, Mr. Hebrank, Mr. Rodriquez, nor anyone from either your office or Mr. Hebrank's office had any communication whatsoever with Mr. Schooler or any of Mr. Schooler's representatives regarding any access to anything at Mr. Schooler's Vista office — and that nobody from Mr. Hebrank's office or your office made any effort to communicate with Mr. Schooler or his counsel regarding the request for access.
