Allen Matkins Leck Gamble Mallory & Natsis LLP ("Allen Matkins"), counsel for Thomas C. Hebrank ("Receiver"), Court-appointed receiver for First Financial Planning Corporation d/b/a Western Financial Planning Corporation ("Western"), and its subsidiaries and the General Partnerships listed in Schedule 1 to the Preliminary Injunction Order entered on March 13, 2013 (collectively, "Receivership Entities"), hereby submits this twenty-third interim application for payment of professional fees and reimbursement of costs for the time period January 1, 2018, through March 31, 2018 ("Twenty-Third Application Period"). Allen Matkins incurred \$64,172.45 in fees and \$1,078.93 in costs during the three-month period and seeks interim approval and payment of 80% of fees incurred, or \$51,337.96, and 100% of costs incurred. As it has throughout the case, Allen Matkins has discounted its customary hourly rates by 10%.

I. FEE APPLICATION SUMMARY

During the Twenty-Third Application Period, Allen Matkins provided a total of 130.1 hours of service for a total of \$64,172.45 in fees. Allen Matkins requests payment on an interim basis of 80% of this amount, or \$51,337.96. The firm has provided its services in the following categories, as discussed in further detail below and as set forth task-by-task in Exhibit A:

As the table reflects, much of the work done during the Twenty-Third Application Period was in the Operations and Asset Sales categories as the Receiver's focus has been on maximizing the value of receivership properties

through sales pursuant to the Court-approved Modified Orderly Sale Process. At this point, the Court has approved sales of receivership properties with purchase prices totaling more than \$19.1 million. Additionally, substantial work was performed during the Twenty-Third Application Period in the General Receivership category. As discussed below, this was non-recurring work to assist with the transfer of GP properties for tax purposes, as authorized by the Court. Dkt. No. 1565. As a result of this work, the receivership estate will save approximately

II. TASKS PERFORMED

\$100,000 annually in fees and costs for preparing and filing GP tax returns.

During the Twenty-Third Application Period, Allen Matkins worked diligently to assist the Receiver with legal issues affecting the receivership. The following is a discussion of Allen Matkins' work, broken down by the categories listed above.

A. General Receivership

Work in this category relates to assisting the Receiver with the transfer of GP properties for tax purposes. During the prior application period, on December 11, 2017, the Court authorized the transfer of GP properties to Western. Dkt. No. 1565. As he proceeded with the transfers, the Receiver was then advised by his tax accountants at Duffy Kruspodin & Company that the properties needed to be transferred to a Qualified Settlement Fund ("QSF") to avoid potential adverse tax consequences. Accordingly, due to the shortness of time to complete the transfers before calendar year end, the Receiver set up the QSF Trust and completed the transfers.

During the Twenty-Third Application Period, Allen Matkins assisted the Receiver in preparing a motion for an amended order authorizing and ratifying the transfers of GP properties to the QSF Trust. Dkt. No. 1571. The motion was granted on February 6, 2018. Dkt. No. 1589.

Allen Matkins also assisted the Receiver in addressing a claim against Western for unpaid pre-receivership taxes, penalties, and late charges asserted by the Franchise Tax Board ("FTB"), including providing information to the FTB, and negotiating a waiver of over \$330,000 in claimed penalties and late charges.

Allen Matkins also researched and advised the Receiver on issues relating to the final GP tax returns and K-1s issued to investors due to the approved closure of the GPs, transfer of the properties to the QSF Trust, distributions to be made to investors from the receivership estate, and recognition of gain or loss by investors on account of these events, including assisting the Receiver in preparing answers to frequently asked questions from investors. The firm also assisted in communicating with counsel for the SEC regarding issues related to enforcement of the Final Judgment against Louis Schooler. The reasonable and necessary fees for work in this category total \$29,193.50.

B. Reporting

This category includes time spent preparing the Receiver's Twenty-Second Interim Report filed on January 24, 2018. Dkt. No. 1582. The report includes detailed updates regarding enforcement of judgments against the LinMar entities, property tax appeals, properties owned by Western, issues with the tenant located on the Stead property, taxes and mortgages, pending and potential sales of GP properties, the investor claims process, and receipts and disbursements for each Receivership Entity. The reasonable and necessary fees for work in this category total \$1,759.50.

C. Operations and Asset Sales

Allen Matkins' time in this category focused on assisting the Receiver with legal issues relating to the ongoing operations of Western and the GPs, including sales of receivership properties via the Modified Orderly Sale Process, easement and condemnation issues, and issues relating to property taxes and assessments.

Prior to the Twenty-Second Application Period, the Court approved the sale of this property to Prologis, LP ("Buyer") for \$9.5 million. Dkt. No. 1511. During the Twenty-Second Application Period, Allen Matkins assisted with issues relating to the closing, including communications with title and escrow. The sale of the property to Buyer closed on January 16, 2018.

2. <u>Dayton II</u>

Allen Matkins assisted the Receiver in preparing a purchase and sale agreement for the Dayton II property, including negotiating terms with the buyer and revising the agreement. The firm then prepared a motion for approval of the sale of the property for \$305,000. The motion was filed on March 7, 2018 (Dkt. No. 1592), a notice that no overbids were received was filed on April 11, 2018 (Dkt. No. 1605), and the motion granted on April 30, 2018 (Dkt. No. 1608).

3. International

Allen Matkins assisted the Receiver in preparing a motion for approval of the sale of the International property for \$39,000. The motion was filed on April 2, 2018 (Dkt. No. 1601), a notice that no overbids were received was filed on May 11, 2018 (Dkt. No. 1612), and the motion was granted on May 18, 2018 (Dkt. No. 1614).

4. Other Issues Pertaining to GP Properties

Allen Matkins advised the Receiver regarding various other legal issues pertaining to GP properties, including assisting with addressing and removing liens on GP properties, working on letters of intent and purchase and sale agreements to be sent to prospective purchasers, and preparing notices to investors regarding offers received for certain GP properties.

The reasonable and necessary fees for Allen Matkins' work in this category total \$21,420.45.

D. Claims and Distributions

This category includes time spent addressing disputed investor claims and preparing the Receiver's reply to the letters and other statements filed by investors with disputed claims. Dkt. No. 1588. Attorney Ted Fates attended the final hearing on disputed investor claims, which was held on February 9, 2018. Dkt. No. 1590. The Court then granted the Receiver's motion for approval of proposed allowed claims amounts. Dkt. No. 1591.

Allen Matkins also assisted in preparing the Receiver's motion for authority to make interim distributions, which was filed on March 9, 2018. Dkt. No. 1594. The motion was granted on April 30, 2018. Dkt. No. 1610. Pursuant to the order, the Receiver will be distributing a total of \$13 million to investors on or before June 15, 2018.

Allen Matkins also assisted in preparing monthly case updates to investors. Finally, the firm analyzed and advised the Receiver regarding a request by an investor to assign his allowed claim against the receivership estate to one of his creditors, pursuant to a settlement agreement between them. The reasonable and necessary fees for this work total \$9,936.

E. Third Party Recoveries

Allen Matkins' work in this category focused on collection of the outstanding judgment against LinMar III. Allen Matkins reviewed the post-judgment receiver's reports and advised on legal issues relating to the post-judgment receivership. In addition, the firm reviewed and advised the Receiver regarding a Notice of Default recorded by the senior lender/deed of trust holder on the LinMar III property. Ultimately, the senior lender rescinded the Notice of Default such that the post-judgment receiver's efforts to market and sell the property may proceed. The reasonable and necessary fees for work in this category total \$1,449.

F. **Employment/Fees**

Although fee applications are a necessary component of federal equity receiverships, neither the Receiver nor his professionals bill time for preparing their own detailed applications. Allen Matkins assisted the Receiver in preparing his Twenty-Second Interim Fee Application, which was filed on March 21, 2018. Dkt. No. 1596. The reasonable and necessary fees for this work total \$414.

G. **Summary of Costs Requested**

Allen Matkins requests the Court approve reimbursement of \$1,078.93 for out-of-pocket costs incurred in executing the foregoing tasks, as itemized in Exhibit A. Pursuant to the Court's Order Granting in Part First Fee Applications, Allen Matkins has reduced its request for reimbursement of copy costs to five cents per page and written off any excess copy charges incurred.

FEES AND COSTS INCURRED AND PAID TO DATE III.

From inception of the receivership on September 6, 2012, through March 31, 14 2018, the Receiver incurred fees and costs of \$2,112,147.66, of which amount 15 \$413,821.71 is subject to holdback pending approval of the Receiver's final fee 16 application at the conclusion of the receivership, \$62,062.74 in fees and costs is 17 awaiting the Court's review and approval in his Twenty-Third Interim Fee 18 19 Application, and \$1,636,263.21 has been approved by the Court and paid. During 20 the same time period, Allen Matkins incurred fees and costs of \$1,645,593.76, of which amount \$337,394.03 is subject to holdback pending approval of Allen Matkins' final fee application at the conclusion of the receivership; \$52,105.26 in 22 fees and costs is awaiting the Court's review and approval in this Twenty-Third 23 Interim Fee Application, and \$1,256,094.47 in fees and costs has been approved by 24 25 the Court and paid. Finally, during the same time period, tax accountant Duffy Kruspodin & Company, LLP ("Duffy") incurred fees and costs of \$731,437.72 for 26 27 preparing tax returns for Western, the GPs, and other non-GP Receivership Entities, all of which has been paid to date, with no holdbacks. 28

IV. APPROVAL OF REQUESTED FEES AND COSTS

In its Order Granting in Part First Interim Fee Applications ("First Fee Order"), the Court analyzed the case law regarding approval of interim fee applications in regulatory receiverships and determined the following factors should be considered: (1) the complexity of the receiver's tasks; (2) the fair value of the time, labor, and skill measured by conservative business standards; (3) the quality of work performed, including the results obtained and the benefit to the receivership estate; (4) the burden the receivership estate may safely be able to bear; and (5) the Commission's opposition or acquiescence. Dkt. No. 169, p. 7.

A. Complexity of Tasks

Here, the tasks performed by Allen Matkins are significantly complex and the number of hours billed to complete them are reasonable. These tasks include (a) analyzing corporate documents, loan agreements, and other contracts, (b) advising the Receiver regarding federal equity receivership, debtor/creditor rights, real property, contract, employment, insurance, eminent domain, tax, civil procedure, appellate procedure, and other applicable areas of law, and (c) assisting the Receiver in selling assets, collecting loans, and protecting the Receivership Entities' interests in pending litigation, (d) assisting the Receiver in analyzing investor claims and distributing receivership assets in a manner that treats investors fairly and equitably, and (e) providing detailed reports to the Court and interested parties.

B. <u>Fair Value of Time, Labor & Skill</u>

The Court has previously determined on multiple occasions, including on April 10, 2017, that the discounted hourly rates of Allen Matkins represent the fair value of their time, labor, and skill. Dkt. No. 1460. Accordingly, Allen Matkins' discounted hourly rates continue to represent the fair value of its time, labor, and skill.

C. Quality of Work Performed

Allen Matkins has diligently and competently assisted the Receiver in all aspects of the receivership, including preserving and protecting the assets of the Receivership Entities, analyzing the Receivership Entities' assets and liabilities, addressing Western's cash shortage, reducing Western's operating expenses as well as administrative expenses of the receivership, selling assets and collecting loans, protecting the Receivership Entities' interests in pending litigation and other legal matters, preserving and pursuing causes of action against third parties, formulating plans and procedures for the determination of investor claims and the fair and equitable distribution of receivership estate assets, and preparing detailed reports to the Court and interested parties. These services have allowed the Receiver to preserve and protect the value of the Receivership Entities' assets for the benefit of investors.

D. Receivership Estate's Ability to Bear Burden of Fees

Pursuant to the Court's May 25, 2016 Order (Dkt. No. 1304), the assets of the Receivership Entities (Western and the GPs) have been pooled, creating a common pool of receivership estate cash from which mortgages, property taxes, and other operating expenses have been and will continue to be paid. The cash balance has grown and will continue to grow as properties are sold through the Court-approved Modified Orderly Sale Process (Dkt. Nos. 1309, 1359). As a result of sales closed to date, the receivership estate now holds approximately \$16.4 million in cash (with \$13 million to be distributed to investors with allowed claims shortly). Therefore, the receivership estate has the ability to pay the fees and costs requested herein.

E. Commission's Opposition or Acquiescence

Prior to filing, the Receiver and Allen Matkins provided these fee applications to counsel for the Commission in substantially final form. Counsel for the Commission has advised that the Commission has no opposition to the fees and costs requested.

Accordingly, the five factors identified by the Court for considering interim 1 fee applications all support interim approval and payment of the requested fees and 2 3 costs. V. **CONCLUSION** 4 WHEREFORE, the Receiver and Allen Matkins respectfully request entry of 5 an order: 6 Approving payment of fees to Allen Matkins on an interim basis of 7 1. \$51,337.96; 8 Approving reimbursement of expenses to Allen Matkins on an interim 9 2. basis of \$1,078.93; 10 Authorizing and directing the Receiver to pay these amounts to Allen 11 3.
