1 The Court, having reviewed the Sixteenth Interim Fee Application of Thomas  
2 Hebrank ("Receiver"), the Court-appointed receiver for Defendant PWCG Trust, for  
3 Payment of Fees and Reimbursement of Expenses ("Application"), including any  
4 supporting declarations and objections filed therein, and being so advised in the  
5 matter and finding good cause, orders as follows:

6 **IT IS ORDERED** that the Receiver's Application is granted.

7 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Receiver's fees and costs for the  
8 Sixteenth Application Period are allowed and approved, on an interim basis, in the  
9 amounts of \$9,480.15 and \$1,208.85.

10 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Receiver is authorized and directed to  
11 pay himself \$7,584.12 in fees and \$1,208.85 in costs from assets of the receivership  
12 estate, which amount reflects an interim payment of 80% of the allowed fees and  
13 100% of the allowed costs.
